SYNDROMES	CASE DEFINITIONS
INFLUENZA-LIKE ILLNESS (ILI)	 Fever (temperature of 100°F <u>AND</u> Cough <u>AND/OR</u> Sore throat [37.8°C] or greater) *Temperature MUST BE MEASURED either at home or in the office. Report of feeling feverish does not meet the case definition.
PROLONGED FEVER (PF)	• Any fever lasting 3 days or longer
ACUTE FEVER AND RASH (AFR)	 Sudden onset of fever with acute non-blistering rash
DENGUE-LIKE ILLNESS (DLI)	 Fever AND At least one of the following: During the two weeks prior to onset of fever, travel to a dengue endemic country or presence in a location experiencing an ongoing dengue outbreak. Association in time and place with a confirmed or probable dengue case. Association in time and place with a confirmed or probable dengue case. At least one of the following: Nausea/vomiting Nausea/vomiting Rash Aches and pains (e.g., headache, retroorbital pain, joint pain, myalgia, arthralgia) Tourniquet test positive Leukopenia (a total white blood cell count of <5,000/mm3), or Any warning sign for severe dengue: Abdominal pain or tenderness Persistent vomiting Extravascular fluid accumulation Mucosal bleeding at any site Liver enlargement >2 centimeters Increasing hematocrit concurrent with rapid decrease in platelet count
DIARRHEA (DIA)	• 3 or more loose or watery stools in 24 hours
