NATURE OF WORK:

Under the general supervision of the Facilities Management Director and the direct supervision of the Plant Operations Manager, the employee in this position performs a wide variety of specialized maintenance and repair work and is also responsible functioning in an essential role as a team leader. The incumbent is responsible for the evaluation and outcome of the needs of the systems and facilities within the premises of Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation (CHCC) in order to maintain smooth, well-ordered operation. This position is situated within the Maintenance Department, Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation (CHCC).

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assigns and assists with work order requests to be assigned to personnel.
- Create, open, update, complete work orders on the Facility Management program while maintaining accurate records on materials used and labor as well as reporting.
- Maintains accurate records of all work order requests and work logs.
- Maintains a scheduled service and repair log for all medical and non-medical equipment.
- Develops, monitors and initiates routine maintenance schedule(s) for all non-medical equipment and medical equipment for operational testing to determine the need for, and the performance of, repair.
- May be required to prepare and submit monthly reports on work order requests completed and pending.
- Organizes inspection schedules for all major contract work of all electrical, mechanical, plumbing, and other maintenance-related systems completed within the confines of Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation (CHCC).
- Monitors renovations and construction of existing and new facilities.
- Coordinates Infection Control Risk Assessments (ICRA) on all renovated and existing facilities.
- Retains an accurate inventory of all medical and non-medical apparatus, tools, spare components and other job-related materials.
- Troubleshoots all mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and other related systems and equipment (including generator engines, HVAC systems, boiler systems, pump motors, vacuum pumps, compressors, oxygen machine compressors, reverse osmosis machines, pump boilers, and medical air compressors) within the facilities of the hospital and any property occupied by satellite locations.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Experience: Five (5) years' experience in two (2) or more trade skills in a hospital environment.

Other: Intermediate proficiency in computer applications. Effective verbal and written communication skills.

CONDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Employment is contingent upon successful clearing of pre-employment health screening and drug screening in accordance with CHCC policy.

OTHERS:

This position is a Full-Time employment status and requires at least 40 hours per week. This position is **"Non-Exempt"** or is eligible to receive overtime compensation pursuant to the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) of 1938 Federal Law. Regular operating hours of the Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation will be Monday to Friday from 7:30am to 4:30pm. This work schedule however is subject to change with or without notice based on the Employer's business requirement and/or by the demands of the employee's job. This position is paid on a bi-weekly basis (2-week period). CHCC adheres to all applicable deductions such as C.N.M.I. Tax, Federal Tax, Medicare and Social Security.
