#### I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) through the Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation (CHCC) is soliciting bid proposals from qualified vendors that are interested in the submitting a bid to Lease total of four (4) SUV vehicles to be used by the Non-Communicable Disease Bureau — Community Health Worker Program. The purchase of these vehicles is necessary for the day-to-day operations and activities for the clients/consumers for the Community Health Worker Program on Saipan, Tinian and Rota. The vehicles will be used primarily to conduct home visits, chronic disease education and outreach activities. The program is needing two (2) SUV's for Saipan, one (1) for Rota, and one (1) for Tinian.

The ITB package contains the necessary information and guidelines for interested vendors to develop and submit bid proposals.

#### II. NATURE OF WORK

During the period of the agreement, the prospective contractor is expected to work with CHCC NCDB staff at the identified location as specified in <u>Section III of this RFP</u>. The prospective contractor is expected to deliver the services in an efficient, trustworthy, and professional manner.

The prospective contractor must have experience to qualify for the award of the contract, the vendor must be able to show proof that it has the manpower, equipment, and financial resources to complete the scope of work as specified in Section IV of this RFB/ITB.
