NATURE OF WORK:

Under the general supervision of the Facilities Management Manager and the direct supervision of the Plant Operations Supervisor, the employee in this position performs entry level on-the-job-training in basic building maintenance trades, such as carpentry, masonry, painting, electrical, plumbing, etc. The incumbent also provides assistance in the repairing, rebuilding and overhauling of mechanical engines. This position is located in the Plant Operations Unit of the Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation (CHCC).

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- On-the-job-training in providing assistance in basic building maintenance trades, such as carpentry, masonry, painting, electrical, plumbing, etc.
- Create, open, update, complete work orders on the Facility Management program while maintaining accurate records on materials used and labor as well as reporting.
- Learns to increase trades skills by performing on the job training and assistance.
- Assists with estimates and costs of the projects.
- Assists with the availability of all required materials, parts, supplies required to complete projects.
- Assists with preparation of requisitions as required.
- Assists with diagnoses for cause for mechanical failure or operation difficulties.
- Assists in the inspection and reports to the supervisor any unusual difficulties encountered and areas of suspected or potential trouble.
- Assists in the clearance and reports all discrepancies before equipment is tested and placed back on line.
- Assists in maintaining reports and records of repair projects as required.
- Assists in mechanical repairs and replacement of motors (e.g., exhaust fan, and compressor).
- Perform HVAC cassette filter replacement and disinfection of exterior housing.
- Remove, clean and repaint diffusers.
- Monitor non-medical and medical equipment parameters for proper working condition.
- Perform daily readings of equipment monitored under the Engineering department.
- Under supervision, perform minor plumbing repairs (e.g., faucet, po plug and p-trap replacement).
- Perform hourly reading on specific equipment to ensure equipment operation.
- Perform daily diesel readings.
- Provide assistance on inventory of parts / supplies and organization.
- Under supervision, perform oxygen refilling and delivery of medical gases.
- Ability to respond as needed on a 24/7 basis and work altered schedules other than standard 7:30 a.m. 16:30 p.m. shift.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: High School Diploma, General Education Development (GED), Advanced Development Institute (ADI), or Adult Basic Education (ABE).

Experience: Plus, three (3) years' experience working in a hospital environment or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Other: Intermediate proficiency in computer applications. Effective verbal and written communication skills.

CONDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Employment is contingent upon successful clearing of pre-employment health screening and drug screening in accordance with CHCC policy.

OTHERS:

This position is a Full-Time employment status and requires at least 40 hours per week. This position is "Non-Exempt" or is eligible to receive overtime compensation pursuant to the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) of 1938 Federal Law. Regular operating hours of the Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation will be Monday to Friday from 7:30am to 4:30pm. This work schedule however is subject to change with or without notice based on the Employer's business requirement and/or by the demands of the employee's job. This position is paid on a bi-weekly basis (2-week period). CHCC adheres to all applicable deductions such as C.N.M.I. Tax, Federal Tax, Medicare and Social Security.

Note(s):
