

CHCC Announces Loan Repayment Program

The Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation (CHCC) is pleased to announce that the Northern Mariana Islands State Loan Repayment Program (CNMI CHCC-SLRP) is accepting applications for FY20 funding. The State Loan Repayment Program will offer primary care, dental, pharmacy, and behavioral health care providers at the CHCC an opportunity to obtain assistance in repaying their educational loans.

In addition to caring for the community they serve, recipients are expected to be involved in workforce development activities such as health career recruitment and teaching. The CNMI CHCC Student Loan Repayment Program is expected to improve the number of providers in medically underserved areas, as well as improve the retention of providers at the CHCC by reducing the burden of educational-related loans on employees.

Who's Eligible?

- Dentists; pharmacists; physician assistants; registered nurses; licensed clinical social workers; and licensed alcohol and substance abuse counselors employed at the CHCC.
- Applicants must be United States citizens or U.S. Nationals.
- Applicants cannot have outstanding contractual obligations for health professional services to the Federal Government, State or other entity, no judgment lien against their property for a debt to the U.S. government, and not be excluded, debarred, suspended, or disqualified by a Federal agency.

All selected will be obligated to commit to 2 years of full-time service at CNMI CHCC-SLRP sites, which are within the CHCC organizational structure.

Instructions for Submitting an Application:

- Applications will be accepted at the CHCC Human Resources Office beginning **January 23, 2023 through February 24, 2023**. Contracts will be awarded on a competitive basis.
